



## Uniform Policy

Introduction and purpose;

This is the Uniform Policy and applies to **Wellington Eagles Primary Academy**, including the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) where applicable.

This policy is published on the academy's website and also available in hard copy on request from the main office.

This Policy is consistent with the Equal Opportunities Policy and applies equally to all pupils, irrespective of their sex, gender reassignment, race, disability, religion or belief or special educational needs, subject to considerations of safety and welfare, following the guidelines of the Equality Act 2010.

## Aims of the policy

- promotes a sense of pride in our school;
- helps to create a sense of community and belonging towards the school;
- identifies the children with the school;
- supports our commitment to inclusion;
- prevents children from wearing 'fashion clothes' that could be distracting in class;
- is practical, smart and designed with health and safety in mind;
- is considered good value for money by most parents;





### Limiting the cost of Uniform

Consideration has been given to the cost of our school uniform, with the vast majority of items available for purchase from supermarkets and a variety of retail outlets, at competitive prices. The only items that must be purchased from our designated supplier are those items with a logo and the school tie.

### Expectations for School Uniform

- All items with a logo must be purchased from our supplier. Any other item may be bought from other retailers.
- Black polishable school shoes are to be worn, not trainers or plimsolls
- Children may have long hair, however this should be tied back at all times with a plain hair tie in school colours – not excessive in size.
- No jewellery should be worn to school, except plain stud earrings and watch (no smart watches or Fitbits allowed)
- Nails - acrylic / fake / painted - not allowed
- All Items should be labelled with your child's name so it can be identified when lost or misplaced.
- Correct uniform must be worn at all times during the day and when travelling to and from the academy.
- Uniform must also be worn for educational visits, unless specified otherwise.

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## RECEPTION, YEARS 1 & 2

- Red sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo \*
- Plain white polo shirt
- Grey trousers, grey tailored shorts, grey pinafore dress or grey skirt.
- Grey/navy socks with trousers and shorts
- Grey or navy tights /white socks with dress or skirt
- Black polishable school shoes, not trainers or plimsolls

## YEARS 3 & 4

- Red V-neck jumper with a gold stripe and school logo \*
- White collared shirt – Short or long sleeved
- Grey trousers, grey tailored shorts or grey skirt
- Grey or navy socks with trousers and shorts
- Grey or navy tights /white socks with skirt
- Black polishable school shoes, not trainers or plimsolls

## YEARS 5 & 6

- Red V-neck jumper with a gold stripe and school logo \*
- Red and gold striped tie \*
- White collared shirt – Short or long sleeved
- Grey trousers, grey tailored shorts or grey skirt
- Grey or navy socks with trousers and shorts
- Grey or navy tights /white socks with skirt
- Black polishable school shoes, not trainers or plimsolls

All year groups will take part in Physical Education. The appropriate clothing must be worn during these classes. The following items can be worn by all year groups:

### Sports kit & outdoor wear

#### Indoor / summer:

- Red T-shirt with school logo\*
- Plain navy shorts
- Plimsolls or trainers



## Outdoor

### Reception, Years 1 and 2:

- Red sweatshirt with school logo\*
- Red T-shirt with school logo\*
- Plain Navy tracksuit bottoms

### Key Stage 2

- Red T-shirt with school logo\*
- Plain navy tracksuit or optional school logo sweatshirt or hoodie\*
- Trainers

***PLEASE NOTE*** that jogging bottoms for all year groups need to have elasticated ankles and be plain, with no branding.

*If a child wears stud earrings to school, they must be able to remove these independently for Physical Education lessons. No other jewellery should be worn.*

### Key stage 2 pupils will need swimming kit:

- Trunks or water shorts or one piece swimming costume (bikini is not suitable)
- Swimming hat and goggles

### Reception, Years 1 and 2

- Red book bag with school logo\*

## All years optional

- Navy outdoor jacket with school logo\*
- Legionnaires cap\*
- Red and white checked summer dress
- Drawstring (Recommended) PE bag\*
- Backpack
- Logo hoodie for outdoors\*



## Headscarves/Hijab

These may be worn for religious reasons but must be in school colours – red, black, or white.

## Jewellery

It is not appropriate for children to wear jewellery except a sensible watch (no smart watches or Fitbits are allowed) and a pair of small plain stud earrings.

## Hairstyles

Hairstyles should be appropriate for school, i.e. no “Mohican, no designs cut into hair, no extremely short hair (no-guard or number 1) or bright coloured highlights. All long hair (shoulder length or longer) should be tied back. Headbands or hair bobbles should be plain dark blue or black and not excessive in size.

## Make-up and Nails

It is not appropriate for children to wear make-up or have false or painted nails. This includes acrylic and gel nails.

### Parents and Carers

Pupils are required to wear uniform correctly and responsibly, as parents/carers this responsibility falls to you. Children should come to school in uniforms that are:

- Clean
- In good condition
- Clearly labelled with the child’s name

If you wish for an amendment to be made to your child’s uniform, you should contact the Admin office as stated above to discuss your child’s needs and a decision will be made by the Senior Leadership Team. If you have any complaints regarding the uniform, please pass these to the class teacher or office staff and we will work together to arrive at a mutually acceptable outcome.

### Staff responsibilities

Staff within the school will closely monitor pupils to make sure they are in correct uniform. They will give any pupils and families breaching the uniform policy the opportunity to comply, but will follow up with the Head of School, if improvements are not made. This includes uniform being correctly worn at all times and of a smart and clean appearance.

## Governors

Our board of Governors will review this policy to make sure that;

- It is still appropriate for the school and the children attending
- They will ensure that this is implemented fairly across all year groups
