

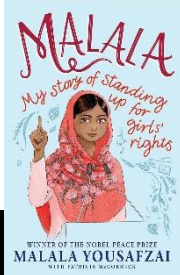
Reading:

We are reading the non-fiction text 'Malala: My story of standing up to girls' rights. We will explore how this text differs from narrative and what we can learn from this inspirational person.

Writing:

We are exploring the familiar text of 'The Three Little Pigs' through journalistic writing. We will explore bias and move on to writing balanced arguments/discussion texts.

Science:

In Science we will begin learning about 'Forces'. We will discuss a range of forces and the effect they have on the world and objects around us.

Maths:

We will be revisiting and building upon our previous learning in calculations, geometry and fractions, decimals and percentages.

RE:
