
Autumn Term 2

Reading:

We will be studying the BFG. We will be developing our love for reading through a rich diet of literature. We will also be developing our comprehension skills such as prediction, retrieval, and inference.

Writing:

In writing, we will be focusing on The Mermaid of Zennor and then Roald Dahl's BFG. We will have opportunities to explore the main characters, make comparisons with similar texts and further opportunities to explore Roald



MFL:

In this term, we will be learning and developing our understanding of physical French phonics as well as digraphs.

Design and Technology

The children will focus on building on the children's repertoire by introducing two new skills: cross-stitch and appliqué. They will then apply their skills to making a decoration.

Computing:

We will learn about online safety and explore Spreadsheets using Purple Mash.

History:

In history this term, we will be investigating what life was like in Britain in the Iron age. We will learn all about the crucial skills to survive in this time period.

RE:

In RE this term, our focus will shift to Christianity and explore the question: Has Christmas lost its true meaning?

PHSE:

In PSHE this term we will focus on Computer Safety and Making Friends Online.

PE:

This term in PE, our focus is Football. By the end of the unit, we will be able to send and receive balls and use a variety of skills and techniques to defend and attack. Please ensure your child has the correct school uniform PE kit

Science:

In science, we will be focusing on rocks. We will be learning about fossils, classifying rocks and enjoying rock experiments.

Maths:

This term we will be developing our knowledge and understanding of Addition and subtraction, Multiplication and division. Within these units, we will focus on applying number bonds within 10, add and subtract 1s, 10s and 100s, equal groups, use arrays, multiples of 2, 5 and 10, Sharing and grouping, Multiply and divide by 3.

Music:

This term in music, we will be creating compositions in response to an animation where we will be able to verbalise how the music makes us feel, create actions or movements appropriate to each section of a piece of music and play melodies and rhythms which represent the section of animation they are accompanying.

Home Learning:

Please read with your child every day if possible, but a minimum of three times a week. Each child also has a Times Table Rockstar login to support them in developing times table fluency. There will also be topic related activities to choose to do through the term, please see the homework grid.
