



<p><u>Communication & Language</u></p> <p>We will be learning new scientific vocabulary linked to our new topic. We will be working on explaining 'why' to explain our ideas to others. In phonics this term we will be covering vocal sounds. Adults will be encouraging children to distinguish the sounds in words and begin to blend them back together e.g. "Can you get your b-a-g please?"</p>	<p><u>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</u></p> <p>We will be looking at how we and other living things grow differently and what we need to survive, such as healthy and nutritious food as well as water. We will be learning how to talk with others and identify feelings to begin to resolve conflicts and issues.</p>	<p><u>Physical Development</u></p> <p>Alongside our usual outdoor provision, we will be exploring how we have changed and grown. This includes showing what we can do now, that we couldn't do before. We will be setting up obstacle courses to show our physical development and looking at how it affects our breathing, body and growth. Where we will decide how to match our movements to the challenge e.g. running, crawling, hopping, climbing etc.</p>
<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>We will be looking at lots of books (fiction and non-fiction) that focus around the growing and changing of living things, beginning to sequence events from stories we have heard. We will be learning to notice some printed letters (such as ones in our own name) in the world around us.</p>	<p>Spring 2 2022/23 February 19th - 28th March Nursery Learning Map</p> 	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>This term we will be focusing on the number 6, height, length, mass and capacity as well as consolidating our knowledge on numbers 1-5 (numerals, counting and subitising). We will be using lots of different resources such as jugs, cups, bowls etc. to explore the measurements and link them to real life.</p>
<p><u>Expressive Art and Design</u></p> <p>We will be using self-chosen materials to create our own unique pictures and models with inspiration from plants, flowers, vegetables and other organic resources. We will follow pitch, melody and tune to sing, using instruments with greater control and purpose in our performances.</p>	<p><u>The Big Question:</u></p> <p>What is alive?
