

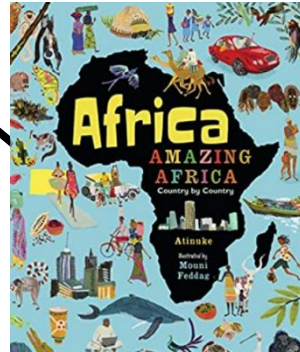
Reading:

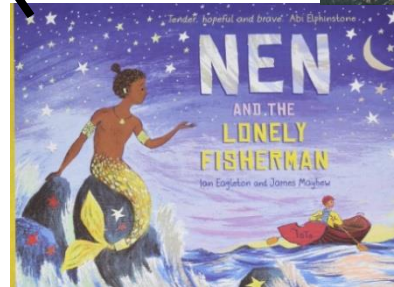


Writing:

In writing this term, we will be looking at the book 'Nen and the lonely fisherman' and writing our own version of the narrative with a twist on the original tale. We will then focus on the book 'Cloud Tea Monkeys' and write a non-chronological report.

PSHE:

Our unit will be 'Our World'. We will be looking at growing, living and working in our world. We will also look at how we can look after our world.



Science:

We will be focusing on rocks and soils. We will look at the appearance and physical properties of rocks, fossil formation and palaeontology and soil formation.

Maths:

We will continue to develop our knowledge of multiplication and division. Then we will focus on length and perimeter looking at adding and subtracting length. After we will begin our fractions unit, identifying unit and non-unit fractions.

Computing:

This term we will focus on emails and branching databases.

PE:

In PE, we will be focusing on tag rugby and dance. Please ensure that you have the school PE kit in school Monday-Friday.

Music:

In music, we will be developing our singing technique. We will be recognising simple rhythmic notation and using this in our singing.

Home Learning:

In DT we will be focusing on building structures. We will be building structures using simple geometric shapes.

Geography:

Our focus this term is 'Who lives in Antarctica?' We will be learning the significance of the lines of latitude, identifying physical and human features of Antarctica and using four-figure grid references to plot Shackleton's route to Antarctica.

RE:

In RE, we will focus on Christianity. We will be looking at Easter and forgiveness with a big question of 'What is 'good' about Good Friday?'
